Dear Investor:

Please find attached this annual report issued by the Independent Review Committee (the "**IRC**") of the publicly offered investment funds (the "**Funds**") managed by Sun Life Global Investments (Canada) Inc. (the "**Manager**"), an indirect subsidiary of Sun Life Financial Inc. This annual report to securityholders of the Funds covers the calendar year 2016 and is given under the requirements of National Instrument 81-107 ("**NI 81-107**"), the securities rule that governs independent review committees in Canada.

Securities regulators have given your IRC a specific role to review mutual fund conflict of interest matters identified and referred to us by the Manager and to give our approval or recommendation. In this regard, for the purposes of this National Instrument, a *conflict of interest matter* is a situation where a reasonable person would consider the Manager (or an entity related to it), to have an interest that may conflict with the ability of the Manager to act in good faith and in the best interests of the Funds. Our focus is on the question of whether the Manager's proposed action achieves a fair and reasonable result for the mutual fund.

We hold regular meetings with the Manager on a quarterly basis and receive at that time the Manager's report of compliance with its policies. In December 2016, we completed an annual review and assessment of the adequacy and effectiveness of the Manager's policies and procedures relating to conflict of interest matters in respect of the Funds. We also hold special meetings to consider conflict of interest matters submitted by the Manager when the need arises.

Concurrently, we completed assessments of our effectiveness as an IRC and the effectiveness and contribution of each of our members. As part of our requirements, we also reviewed the compensation and independence of our members.

The IRC has initiated a succession planning process in order to replace all of its members in a staggered process ending in August 2019.

The members of the IRC, whose identities are listed in the report, bring to their roles a combination of educational and professional experience and skills to adequately address the scope of the conflict of interest matters that come before the IRC. The industry information and ongoing continuing education provided to us by the Manager help us to maintain high standards and best practices in mutual fund governance.

We are pleased to publish this annual report to securityholders of the Funds.

As at March 29, 2017 no member of the IRC beneficially owned, directly or indirectly, any security of any person or company that provides services to the Funds or the Manager.

Compensation and Indemnities

The aggregate compensation paid by the Funds to the IRC as the independent review committee of the Funds for the year was \$32,500 to the Chair and \$26,500 to each other member. This compensation was in line with the Manager's recommendation. This amount was allocated among the Funds in a manner that was considered by the Manager as fair and reasonable to the Funds.

No indemnities were paid to the members of the IRC by the Funds during the period.

At least annually, the IRC reviews its compensation giving consideration to the following:

- 1. the best interest of the Funds;
- 2. that each Fund must pay its reasonable allocation of the compensation of the members of your IRC from the assets of the Fund;
- 3. that compensation paid to your IRC by each Fund should fairly and reasonably reflect the general and specific benefits accruing to the Fund;
- 4. the number, nature and complexity of the Funds for which your IRC acts; and
- 5. the nature and extent of the workload of each member of your IRC.

Conflict of Interest Matters

Approvals and Recommendations

The IRC is not aware of any instance in which the Manager acted in a conflict of interest matter but did not meet a condition imposed by the IRC in its recommendations or approval. The Manager has an obligation to notify the IRC of any such instances.

Policies and Procedures and Standing Instructions

The Manager has policies and procedures in place to address conflict of interest situations. The Manager received standing instructions with respect to potential conflict of interest matters addressed by the following policies. In each case, the standing instructions require the Manager to comply with its related policy and procedures and to report periodically to your IRC.

- 2. Allocation of Fees and Expenses

- 3. Best Execution
- 4. Error Correction
- 5. Standards of Fairness in the Allocation of Trade Opportunities
- 6. Fund Asset Valuation

- 9. Sub-Advisor Oversight
- 10. Proxy Voting
- 11. Short Term Trading and Late Trading
- 12. Soft Dollars
- 13. Trading with a related Broker/Dealer
- 14. Transactions in Securities of Related Issuers

The Manager acted throughout the year in accordance with the IRC standing instructions.

Positive Recommendations

During the period, the IRC provided approval to the Manager to effect the merger of each of the Sun Life MFS Balanced Value Fund and Sun Life MFS Balanced Growth Fund (the Terminating Funds) into the Sun Life Granite Balanced Portfolio (the Continuing Fund). These mergers were completed on August 26, 2016.

In accordance with the requirements of National Instruments 81-102 and 81-107, the IRC did not have to consider any other conflict of interest situation in 2016.
